


Halloween Candy Dish



YOU WILL NEED:

Pegboards:

4 large squares

Other:

Iron and ironing paper
Scissors and clear tape
Tweezers
Two 14" x 14" pieces of sturdy cardboard
Masking tape (optional)
Large rubber band

Bead Colors:

- Orange - 221
 - Cheddar - 176
 - Green - 91
 - Dark Green - 27
 - Light Brown - 30
 - Brown - 86
 - Black - 73
 - White* - 1221
- *2 bags needed

Instructions


1. Assemble 4 large square pegboards as shown to create your project, placing them on one of the large pieces of cardboard on a heat-safe surface that you can later use for fusing. Cut out and tape together the pattern sections. If you are using clear pegboards, slide the actual-size pattern underneath them. Place your beads following the pattern.


2. **TIP: For best results, fuse the first side lightly and the second side well.**


Ask an adult to fuse your design—you can use our Standard Fusing Method explained here on page 4. Follow the additional instructions for shaping the edges of the dish.

You might prefer to use the Tape Method for Fusing Large Projects, which works well for projects on multiple pegboards. You can find The Tape Method under Projects at www.perler.com. Be sure to note the tip above. After fusing and while the beads are still warm, pull the "wing" edges up and hold with a rubber band until cool.

Fusing Instructions—Only Adults Iron



1. Place your pegboard on a flat, heat-safe surface.
2. Set a household iron to the medium setting. Place ironing paper over the pegboard. In a circular motion, begin to iron the project. Do not press down with the iron. As the beads begin to fuse, you will see circles of the beads start to show through the paper. Fuse this side lightly, then let the design cool.
3. Remove the paper and bead design from the pegboard. Flip the design over to expose the non-fused side. Repeat step two but fuse well. While the beads are still warm, pull the “wing” edges up and hold in place with the large rubber band. Let cool completely. Your pegboard and ironing paper are reusable.

NOTE: Beads need heat for about 10-20 seconds per side to fuse evenly. Lift the paper occasionally to see how the beads are fusing. Depending on the size of the project, additional heating time may be required. **DO NOT OVER-IRON** the beads as it will make the centers of the beads close and can make the shaping you do with your project more challenging.
