Pegboards:

- Small square
- Small circle
- Small heart

Other:



- Ironing paper and iron
- Cardstock to make cards
- Thick craft glue
- Journaling pen (optional)

Bead Colors:



- Light Pink - 49







Instructions

1. If you are using clear pegboards, slide the actual-size patterns underneath them. Place your beads on the pegboards as shown.
2. Ask an adult to fuse your designs—see page 3 for further instructions.
3. Assembly: see page 3.



Tip: Orient your circle pegboard so the pegs match the blue lines shown.





Fusing Instructions—Only Adults Iron



1. Place your pegboard on a flat, heat-safe surface.
2. Set a household iron to the medium setting. Place ironing paper over the pegboard. In a circular motion, begin to iron the project. Do not press down with the iron. As the beads begin to fuse, you will see circles of the beads start to show through the paper. When ironed properly, the beads will still have an open center. Let the design cool.
3. Remove the paper and bead design from the peg board. Flip the design over to expose the non-fused side. Repeat step two. Let cool completely.

NOTE: Beads need heat for about 10-20 seconds per side to fuse evenly. Lift the paper occasionally to see how the beads are fusing. Additional heating time may be required.

ASSEMBLY

1. Cut your cardstock to the desired size for the card base and fold in half for a top-folding or side-folding card.
2. Cut a panel in a contrasting color of cardstock that is 1/4" small all around than the card front.
3. Decide which bead designs you want to put on your card and the message you want to write. Try different layouts or follow the photo. Pen your message, or print it with your computer in a fun font. Glue the panel to the card front, then glue the bead designs in place.
